



Client Alert: Illinois Annual Sexual Harassment Prevention Training

Employers in Illinois with one (1) or more employees require annual sexual harassment training for all employees.

As noted in a [previous Engage Alert](#), the **deadline by which all Illinois employers must have their initial annual training for their employees is December 31, 2020**. Therefore, any employers that are still not in compliance are strongly encouraged to have their employees trained as soon as possible.
